**THE SANCTUARY LAMP** signals the Eucharistic presence of the Lord Jesus in the tabernacle and burns continuously for 7 days. You may have the sanctuary lamp memorialized for either a sick person, a deceased loved one, or a special intention, for a weekly donation of \$25.00. To schedule a date, check the sheet on the bulletin board in the hall and then fill out an envelope found on the credenza for this purpose.
