SACRAMENTS:

BAPTISM: Call the Rectory at least one month before the proposed date to arrange for preparation and date for Baptism. Parents must be registered and active parishioners for at least 3 months prior to the Baptism.

MATRIMONY: If you are a Catholic and want to be married (even if at another church) you must call the Rectory at least six months prior to the proposed date to arrange for marriage.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS/MASS for the Season of Lent: Our Lady of Hope church, Manning on Wednesdays and **St. Ann's Church, Santee on Fridays** starting at **5.30PM**. St. Ann's will have soup and sandwiches after the stations in the social hall. There will be **NO** Friday morning Masses during Lent.

THE SANCTUARY LAMP signals the Eucharistic presence of the Lord Jesus in the tabernacle and burns continuously for 7 days. You may have the sanctuary lamp memorialized for either a sick person, a deceased loved one, or a special intention, for a weekly donation of \$25.00. To schedule a date, check the sheet on the bulletin board in the hall and then fill out an envelope found on the credenza for this purpose.

ALTAR FLOWERS: Parishioners who would like to place flowers on the altar for a special request on any weekend, please sign up on the sheet on the bulletin board. Flowers are for altar (in front) and/or for the flower stands. Real flowers are preferred. You may order the flowers yourself, or bring flowers from your garden, or use potted plants which can be taken home afterwards.
