WHAT IS PASTORAL PLANNING?

WEEK THREE - As we move closer to our September meeting, let us reflect further; what is Pastoral Planning? The first two elements of Pastoral Planning are Process and Praying. Pastoral Planning is a process, not simply an activity, but a purposeful set of activities that should make the best use of our human understanding about effective group action. Praying, the most detectable difference between ordinary planning and pastoral planning is the central role of prayer and faith sharing. The work of pastoral planning is the work of the Holy Spirit done through and with us here at St Ann's. While recited prayers are important, they should prepare us for a scripture-based faith sharing in which we at St Ann's are called to reflect on the ways in which God is and has been present in our lives and to share those stories with our fellow parishioners.
