RIGHT TO LIFE ACTIVITIES FOR FEBRUARY: Forty days for life begins in Charleston on **February 18th and ends on March 29th**. If you are in Charleston during this period your witness at the abortion clinic would be appreciated. The bishop will be participating in a candle light rosary at the clinic on February 24th at 7PM. There will be a rosary at the clinic on February 21 at 8:00 AM hosted by a local parish. The above activities will take place at the Charleston women's center (abortion clinic) at 1312 Ashley River Road Charleston, SC 29407 We are approaching 60 million babies killed since 1973. That number is a challenge for me to put in perspective: is it for you also? There is a moving site (remember the unborn.org), it is virtual memorial that may help you grasp the magnitude of injustice imposed on God's most precious and innocent.

2015 BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL: This weekend starts the 2015 Bishop's Annual Appeal which will be conducted over the balance of the month. Our parish motto for this year is "continue the good work". Your generosity on the parish level and extending out to the community through our Outreach program has been outstanding. The bishop's annual appeal provides an opportunity to reach out further. The funds raised are used to support various diocesan ministries. Last year we raised \$10,265 and the number of donors was 55, down from the prior year's 66. Because we exceeded our goal of \$5,909 we will receive a rebate of \$2,228 (one half of the amount exceeding our goal). This year we would like to match last year's accomplishment. If everyone contributes something (remember the mustard seed), regardless of the amount, we can accomplish our goal.

You will be receiving in the mail a letter from the Bishop as well as your pledge envelope. You can make your pledge or donation (checks preferred) anytime during the month either directly by mail to the Diocese in Charleston or by putting your completed envelope in the collection basket.

Thank you for giving some thought and prayer into making a decision and hopefully following with a pledge or donation. This is your chance to "continue the good work".
