There will be a rosary at the clinic on February 21 at 8:00 AM hosted by a local parish. The above activities will take place at the Charleston women's center (abortion clinic) at 1312 Ashley River Road Charleston, SC 29407 We are approaching 60 million babies killed since 1973. That number is a challenge for me to put in perspective: is it for you also? There is a moving site (remember the unborn.org) , it is virtual memorial that may help you grasp the magnitude of injustice imposed on God's most precious and innocent.
