Facts of Our Faith

The Catholic teaches that God has revealed himself to humankind as a Trinity of Persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Trinity is the central doctrine of the Catholic faith. Upon it are based all other teachings of the Church. In the New Testament there is frequent mention of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. The three divine Persons produce all effects of God's actions upon his creations in common. But because certain effects of the divine action remind us more of one divine Person than another, the Church attributes particular effects to one or the other divine Person. Thus we speak of the Father as Creator of all things, of the Son, the Word of God, as our Savior, and of the Holy Spirit, the love of God poured into our hearts, as our Sanctifier.
