THE MYSTERIES OF CHRIST'S LIFE

"O marvelous exchange! Man's Creator has become man, born of the virgin. We have been made sharers in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share our humanity." (The Antiphon I of Evening Prayer for January 1st.) We can scarcely take it in: Emmanuel, God with us, a humbling thought that God would come to earth to live like us and then redeem us by his passion, death on the cross and resurrection. The whole of Christ's life was a continual teaching: his silences, his miracles, his gestures, his prayer, his love for people, his special affection for the little and the poor. During the greater part of his life Jesus shared the condition of the vast majority of human beings: a daily life spent without evident greatness, a life of manual labor. His religious life was that of a Jew obedient to the Law of God, a life in the community. Jesus' hidden life at Nazareth allows everyone to enter into fellowship with Jesus by the most ordinary events of daily life.
