THE MYSTERIES OF JESUS' PUBLIC LIFE

Jesus' public life begins with his baptism by John in the Jordan River. This is the manifestation, the Epiphany of Jesus as Messiah of Israel and Son of God. The baptism of Jesus is on his part the acceptance and inauguration of his mission as God's suffering Servant. John the Baptist is the last of the prophets and he links the Old Testament to the New Covenant in Jesus. In his baptism Jesus allows himself to be numbered among the sinners coming to John for Baptism. John hesitates but Jesus insists. John calls Jesus the Lamb of God come to take away the sin of the world. The Father's voice responds to his son's acceptance of his mission. The Spirit comes to rest on Jesus who will become the source of the Spirit for all mankind. At Jesus' baptism the heavens were opened, the heavens that Adam's sin had closed. Through Baptism we Christians are sacramentally assimilated to Jesus who in his own baptism anticipates his death and resurrection. We go down in to the water of baptism to rise with him to eternal life.
