### **Facts of Our Faith**

#### JESUS AND ISRAEL

Some Jewish leaders and partisans of Herod thought Jesus was indifferent to full obedience of their Law. Jesus performed acts, such as pardoning sins, that manifested Him to be the Savior God Himself (John 5:16-18).

Certain Jews, who did not recognize God made man (John 1:14), saw in Him only a man who made Himself God (John 10:33), and judged Him as a blasphemer.

Jesus accepted the Mosaic Law but He brought it to fulfillment as He explained in the Sermon on the Mount.

\*He subjected Himself to the Law as the Incarnate Son of God.

\*He provided the grace for His followers to live the Law beyond anything expected in the Old Testament.

\*He gave us the Beatitudes, which are the definitive interpretation of Mosaic Law.

\*He revealed depths of meaning in the Law that only God- become-man could recognize.
