THE PASSION OF CHRIST

Christ's death is part of God's mysterious providence: As St. Peter says, Christ was handed over to His enemies "according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God." That is why the second person of the Trinity assumed a human nature, in order to expiate the sins of the human race. The desire to embrace His Father's plan of redeeming love inspired Jesus' whole life, for His redemptive passion was the very reason for His Incarnation.
