Facts of Our Faith

Article 5 of the Apostles creed:

III THE MEANING AND SAVING SIGNIFICANCE OF THE RESURRECTION

651 "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain." The Resurrection above all constitutes the confirmation of all Christ's works and teachings. All truths, even those more inaccessible to human reason, find their justification in Christ by his Resurrection has given the definitive proof of his divine authority, which he had promised.

652 Christ's Resurrection is the fulfillment of the promises both of the Old Testament and of Jesus himself during his early life. The phrase "in accordance with the Scriptures" indicates that Christ's Resurrection fulfilled these predictions.

653 The truth of Jesus' divinity is confirmed by his Resurrection. He had said: "When you have lifted up the Son of man then you will know that I am he." The Resurrection of the crucified one shows that he was truly "I Am," the Son of God and God himself. So St. Paul could declare to the Jews: "What God promised to the fathers, this he has fulfilled to us their children by raising Jesus; as also it is written in the second psalm, 'You are my Son, today I have begotten you.' " Christ's Resurrection is closely linked to the Incarnation of God's Son and is its fulfillment in accordance with God's eternal plan.

654 The Paschal mystery has two aspects: by his death, Christ liberates us from sin; by his Resurrection, he opens for us the way to a new life. This new life is above all justification that reinstates us in God's grace, "so that as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. Justification consists in both victory over the death caused by sin and a new participation in grace. It brings about adoption so that we become Christ's brethren. We are brethren not by nature but by the gift of grace.

BISHOP'S ANNUAL APPEAL: As of 4/1/16 our parish members pledged or donated \$9,309 to the 2016 Bishop's Annual Appeal. We have exceeded the goal assigned to us by the Diocese by \$2,986. Therefore, to date, we will receive \$1,993 back from the Diocese. The campaign will continue to the end of this year. To date 43 parishioners have either pledged or donated money. This is short of our goal of having 51 parishioners (the number from 2015) participate. Regardless of the dollar amount (remember the mustard seed) every little bit counts. It is not too late to contribute. To those who have not participated please consider doing so. Envelopes are available on the credenza or just put a check in an envelope, marked Bishop's Annual Appeal, and place it in the collection basket. We will make sure it gets forwarded to Charleston.
