Facts of Our Faith

Article 6 of the Apostles creed:
“HE ASCENDED INTO HEAVEN AND IS SEATED AT THE RIGHT
HAND OF THE FATHER”

662 “ And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all men to myself.”
The lifting up of Jesus on the cross signifies and announces his lifting up by his
Ascension into heaven, and indeed begins it. Jesus Christ, the one priest of the
new and eternal Covenant “ entered not into a Sanctuary made by human hands,
but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God on our behalf.”
There Christ permanently exercises his priesthood, for he always lives to make
intercession for those who draw near to God through him. As high priest of the
good things to come he is the center and the principle actor of the liturgy that
honors the Father in heaven.

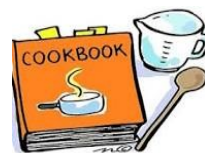
663 Henceforth Christ is seated at the right hand of the Father. “By ‘the Fa-
ther’s right hand’ we understand the glory and honor of divinity, where he who
exists as the Son of God before all ages, indeed as God, of one being with the
Father, is seated bodily after he became incarnate and his flesh was glorified.

664 Being seated at the Father’s right hand signifies inauguration of the Messi-
ah’s kingdom, the fulfillment of the prophet Daniel’s vision concerning the Son
of man: “To him was given dominion and glory and kingdom, that all peoples,
nations and languages should serve him; his dominion is an everlasting domin-
ion which shall not pass away and his kingdom one that shall not be destroyed.”
After this event the Apostles became witnesses of the kingdom that will have no
end.
