Facts of Our Faith

□ Article 7 of the Apostles creed:

□ "From THENSE HE WILL COME AGAIN TO JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD"

□ I He Will Come Again In Glory

□ The glorious advent of Christ, the hope of Israel

□ 674 The glorious Messiah's coming is suspended at every moment of history until his recognition by "all Israel for a hardening has come upon part of Israel in their unbelief" toward Jesus. St. Peter says to the Jews of Jerusalem after Pentecost:"

□ Repent therefore and turn again, that your sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, whom heaven must receive until the time for establishing all that God spoke by mouth of his holy prophets from of old." St Paul echoes him: "For if their rejection means the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance mean but life from the dead?" The full inclusion of the Jews in the Messiah's salvation in the wake of "the full number of the Gentiles, will enable the People of God to achieve "the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ, in which God may be all in all."

□ The Church's ultimate trial

□ 675 Before Christ's second coming the Church must pass through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers. The persecution that accompanies her pilgrimage on earth will unveil the "mystery of iniquity" in the form of a religious deception offering men an apparent solution to their problems at the price of apostasy from the truth. The supreme religious deception is that of the Antichrist, a pseudo-messianism by which man glorifies himself in place of God and of his Messiah come in the flesh.

□ 676 The Antichrist's deception already begins to take shape in the world every time the claim is made to realize within history that messianic hope which can only be realized beyond history through the final judgment.
