Facts of Our Faith

Article 8 of the Apostles creed:
I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

III GOD'S SPIRIT AND WORD IN THE TIME OF PROMISES

702 From the beginning until "the fullness of time" the joint mission of the Father's Word and Spirit remains hidden, but it is at work. God's Spirit prepares for the time of the Messiah. Neither is fully revealed but both are already promised, to be watched for and welcomed at their manifestation. So, for this reason, when the Church reads the Old Testament, she searches there for what the Spirit "who has spoken through the prophets," wants to tell us about Christ.

In creation

703 The Word of God and his Breath are at the origin of the being and life of every creature. It belongs to the Holy Spirit to rule, sanctify, and animate creation, for he is God, consubstantial with the Father and Son.....Power over life pertains to the Spirit for being God he preserves creation in the Father through the Son.

704 "God fashioned man with his own hands and impressed his own form on the flesh he had fashioned, in such a way that even what was visible might bear the divine form.

The Spirit of the promise

705 Disfigured by sin and death, man remains "in the image of God" in the image of the Son, but is deprived "of the glory of God" of his "likeness." The promise made to Abraham inaugurates the wealth of salvation, at the culmination of which the Son himself will assume that "image" and restore it in the Father's likeness by giving it again its Glory, the Spirit who is "the giver of life."
