Facts of Our Faith

Article 9 of the Apostles creed:

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY Catholic Church

Paragraph 1. The Church in God's Plan

II. The Church's Origin, Foundation, and Mission

The Church----prepared for in the Old Covenant

762 The remote preparation for this gathering together of the People of God begins when he calls Abraham and promises that he will become the Father of a great people. Its immediate preparation begins with Israel's election as the People of God. By this election Israel is to be the sign of the future gathering of all nations. But the prophets accuse Israel of behaving like a prostitute. They announce a new and eternal covenant. "Christ instituted this New Covenant."

The Church -----instituted by Christ Jesus

763 It was the Son's task to accomplish the Father's plan of salvation in the fullness of time. Its accomplishment was the reason for his being sent. "The Lord Jesus inaugurated his Church by preaching the Good News, that is, the coming of the Reign of God, promised over the ages in scriptures. To fulfill the Father's will, Christ ushered in the Kingdom of heaven on earth. The Church "is the reign of Christ already present in mystery."

764 "This Kingdom shines out before men in the word, in the works and the presence of Christ." To welcome Jesus' word is to welcome "the Kingdom itself." The seed and the beginning of the Kingdom are the "little flock" of those whom Jesus came to gather around him, the flock whose shepherd he is. They form Jesus' true family. To those whom he thus gathered around him, he taught a new "way of acting" and a prayer of their own.

769 The Lord Jesus endowed his community with a structure that will remain until the Kingdom is fully achieved. Before all else there is the choice of the twelve with Peter as the head. Representing the twelve tribes of Israel, they are they foundation stones of the new Jerusalem. The twelve and the other disciples share in Christ's mission and his power, but also in his lot. By all his actions, Christ prepares and builds his Church.

COLUMBARIUM UPDATE: It has been several weeks since the last discussion of the Columbarium effort has been in these Bulletins (8-21-16). We have had some complications but the project is scheduled to go ahead and here is what we need for you to know: (1) It has been necessary to revise our preliminary costs estimates upward because the number of spaces in this columbarium is fewer than what we were given to believe and of some changes suggested by the Diocese increased costs; and, (2) We must have our money collected and the structure ordered before December 1st as prices may increase from the manufacturer. We will be sending letters to those of you who told us they were interested (about 29 Parishioners) but want all of you to know that pre-construction prices for this columbarium will be significantly lower than post construction pricing.
