Article 9 of the Apostles creed:

The Church -----perfected in glory

769 "The Church will receive its perfection only in the glory of heaven," at the time of Christ's glorious return. Until that day, "the Church progresses on her pilgrimage amidst this world's persecutions and God's consolations." Here below she knows that she is in exile far from the Lord, and longs for the full coming of the Kingdom, when she will be reunited in glory with her king. The Church, and through her the world, will not be perfected in glory without great trials. Only then will "all the just from the time of Adam, 'from Abel, the just one, to the last of the elect', be gathered together in the universal Church in the Father's presence.

III. The Mystery of the Church

770 The Church is in history, but at the same time she transcends it. It is only "with the eyes of faith" that one can see her in her visible reality and at the same time in her spiritual reality as bearer of divine life.

The Church----- both visible and spiritual

771 "The one mediator, Christ, established and ever sustains here on earth his holy Church, the community of faith, hope, and charity as a visible organization through which he communicates truth and grace to all men. The Church is at the same time:

_____ a "society structured with hierarchical organs and the mystical body of Christ;

_____ the visible society and the spiritual community;

_____ the earthly Church and the Church endowed with heavenly riches.

These dimensions together constitute "one complex reality which comes together from a human and a divine element."
