Facts of Our Faith

Article 9 of the Apostles creed:

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY Catholic Church

Paragraph 1. The Church in God's Plan

III. The Mystery of the Church

The universal Sacrament of salvation

775 The Church, in Christ, is like a sacrament, a sign and instrument, that is, of communion with God and of unity among all men. The Church's first purpose is to be the sacrament of the inner union of men with God. Because men's communion with one another is rooted in that union with God, the Church is also the sacrament of unity with the human race. In her, this unity is already begun, since she gathers men "from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and tongues" at the same time, the Church is the "sign and instrument" of the full realization of the unity yet to come.

776 As sacrament, the Church is Christ's instrument. "She is taken up by him also as the instrument for salvation of all," "the universal sacrament of salvation," by which Christ is at once manifesting and actualizing the mystery of God's love for men." The Church is the visible plan of God's love for humanity, because God desires "that the whole human race may become one People of God, form one body of Christ, and be built up into one temple of the Holy Spirit."

777 The word "Church" means convocation. It designates the assembly of those whom God's Word "convokes," i.e. gathers together to form the People of God, and who themselves, nourished with the body of Christ, become the Body of Christ.

778 The Church is both the means and the goal of God's plan: prefigured in creation, prepared for in the Old Covenant, founded by the words and actions of Jesus Christ, fulfilled by his redeeming cross and his Resurrection, the Church has been manifested as the mystery of salvation by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. She will be perfected in the glory of heaven as the assembly of all the redeemed of the earth.

779 The Church is both visible and spiritual, a hierarchical society and the Mystical Body of Christ. She is one, yet formed of two components, human and divine. That is her mystery, which only faith can accept.
