### Facts of Our Faith

Article 9 of the Apostles creed:

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY Catholic Church

Paragraph 2. The Church----People of God, Body of Christ, Temple of the Holy Spirit

I. The church---People of God

781 “At all times and in every race, anyone who fears God and does what is right has been acceptable to him. He has, however, willed to make men holy and save them, not as individuals without any bond or link between them, but rather to make them into a people who might acknowledge him and serve him in holiness. He therefore chose the Israelite race to be his own people and established a covenant with it. He gradually instructed this people. All these things happened as a preparation for and figure of that new and perfect covenant which was to be ratified in Christ: the New Covenant in his blood: he called together a race made up of Jews and Gentiles which would be one, not according to the flesh, but in the Spirit.”

Characteristics of the People of God.

782 The People of God is marked by characteristics that clearly distinguish it from all other religious, ethnic, political, or cultural groups found in history: It is the People of God.

God is not the property of any one people. But he acquired a people for himself from those who previously were not a people: “a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation.” One becomes a member of this people not by a physical birth, but by being “born anew,” a birth of water and the Spirit, that is, by faith in Christ, and Baptism. This People has for its head Jesus the Christ, the anointed, the Messiah. Because the same anointing, the Holy Spirit, flows from the head into the body, this is “the messianic people.” The status of this people is that of the dignity and freedom of the sons of God, in whose hearts the Holy Spirit dwells as in a temple.” Its law is the new commandment to love as Christ loved us. This is the new law of the Holy Spirit. Its destiny is the Kingdom of God which has been begun by God himself on earth and which must be further extended until it has been brought to perfection by him at the end of time.
