Facts of Our Faith

Article 9 of the Apostles creed:
I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY Catholic Church
Paragraph 2. The Church----People of God, Body of Christ, Temple of the Holy Spirit

II The church---Body of Christ
The Church is communion with Jesus
“Christ is the Head of this Body”
795 Christ and his Church thus together make up the “whole Christ.” The Church is one with Christ. The saints are acutely aware of this unity: Let us rejoice then and give thanks that we have become not only Christians, but Christ himself. Do you understand and grasp, brethren, God’s grace toward us? Marvel and rejoice: we have become Christ. For if he is the head and we are the members, he and we together are the whole man . . . The fullness of Christ then is the head and the members. But what does “head and members mean? Christ and the Church.

Our redeemer has shown himself to be one person with the holy Church who he has taken to himself.
Head and members form as it were one and the same mystical person.

A reply of St. Joan of Arc to her judges sums up the faith of the holy doctors and the good sense of the believer: about Jesus Christ and the Church, I simply know they are just one thing, and we shouldn’t complicate the matter.
The Church is the Bride of Christ

796 The unity of Christ and the Church, head and members of one Body, also implies the distinction of the two within a personal relationship. This image is often expressed by the image of bridegroom and bride. The theme of Christ as Bridegroom was prepared for by the prophets and announced by John the Baptist. The Lord referred to himself as the “bridegroom.” The Apostle speaks of the whole Church and of each of the faithful, members of his Body, as a bride “betrothed” to Christ the Lord so as to become but one spirit with him. The Church is the spotless bride of the spotless Lamb. “Christ loved the Church and himself up for her, that he might sanctify her.” He has joined her with himself in an everlasting covenant and never stops caring for her as for his own body.

A DAY OF PENANCE AND PRAYER: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (Beginning on January 22, 2003) has made mandatory the following day of Penance and Prayer. "In all dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or 23, when the 22nd falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life". Abortion demand was made the law of the land on January 22, 1973 (Roe V. Wade) Since that time approximately 59 million babies have been surgically aborted in the USA. It has also been estimated an additional 250 million babies have been chemically aborted. As the 22nd falls on Sunday this year the **day of Penance and Prayer will be on Monday the 23rd.** Please take the time on Monday the 23rd to give voice to the ones that do not have a voice and pray one rosary for them
