Facts of Our Faith

- Article 9 of the Apostles creed:
I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY Catholic Church
Paragraph 2. The Church---People of God, Body of Christ, Temple of the Holy Spirit
- III The church Is the Temple of the Holy Spirit
- 797 “What the soul is to the human body, the Holy Spirit is to the Body of Christ, which is the Church.” “To this Spirit of Christ, as an invisible principle, is to be ascribed the fact that all the parts of the body are joined one with the other and with their exalted head; for the whole Spirit of Christ is in the head, and the whole Spirit is in the body, and the whole Spirit is in each of the members.” The Holy Spirit makes the Church “the temple of the living God.” Indeed, it is to the Church that the “Gift of God” has been entrusted. It is in her that communion with Christ has been deposited, that is to say the Holy Spirit, the pledge of incorruptibility, the strengthening of our faith and the ladder of our ascent to God. For where the Church is, there also is God’s Spirit; Where God’s Spirit is, there is the Church and every grace.
- 798 The Holy Spirit is “the principle of every vital and truly saving action in each part of the body.” He works in many ways to build up the whole Body in charity: by God’s Word “which is able to build you up”; by baptism, through which he forms Christ’s body; by the sacraments, which give growth and healing to Christ’s members; by the grace of the apostles, which holds first place among his gifts; by the virtues, which make us act according to what is good; finally, by the many special graces (called charisms), by which he makes the faithful fit and ready to undertake various tasks and offices for the renewal and building up of the Church.

- 799 Whether extraordinary or simple and humble, Charisms are graces of the Holy Spirit which directly or indirectly benefit the Church, ordered as they are to her building up, to the good of men, and to the needs of the world.

A DAY OF PENANCE AND PRAYER: The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (Beginning on January 22, 2003) has made mandatory the following day of Penance and Prayer. "In all dioceses of the United States of America, January 22 (or 23, when the 22nd falls on a Sunday) shall be observed as a particular day of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion, and of prayer for [the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life". Abortion demand was made the law of the land on January 22, 1973 (Roe V. Wade) Since that time approximately 59 million babies have been surgically aborted in the USA. It has also been estimated an additional 250 million babies have been chemically aborted. As the 22nd falls on Sunday this year the **day of Penance and Prayer will be on Monday the 23rd**. Please take the time on Monday the 23rd to give voice to the ones that do not have a voice and pray one rosary for them
