Paragraph 3. The Church Is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic

III The Church Is Catholic

The Church and non-Christians

839 "Those who have not yet received the Gospel are related to the Church in various ways."

840 The relationship of the Church with the Jewish people: When she delves into her own mystery, the Church, the People of God in the new covenant, discover her link with the Jewish People, the first to hear the word of God. The Jewish faith, unlike other non-Christian religions, is already a response to God's revelation in the Old Covenant. To the Jews belong the sonship, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the worship and the promises; to them belong the patriarchs, and their race, according to the flesh, is the Christ; for the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable.

840 And when one considers the future, God's People of the Old Covenant and the new People of God tend towards similar goals: **expectation** of the coming, or the return, of the Messiah. But one awaits the return of the Messiah who died and rose from the dead and is recognized as Lord and Son of God; the other awaits the coming of a Messiah, whose features remain hidden till the end of time; and the latter waiting is accompanied by the drama of not knowing or of misunderstanding Christ Jesus.

841 The Church's relationship with the Muslims: "the plan of salvation also includes those who acknowledge the Creator, in the first place amongst whom are the Muslims: these profess to hold the faith of Abraham, and together with us they adore the one merciful God, mankind's judge on the last day.
