Facts of Our Faith

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 3. The Church Is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic

III The Church Is Catholic

Outside the Church there is no salvation

846 How are we to understand this affirmation, often repeated by the Church Fathers?

Re-formulated positively, it means that all salvation comes from Christ the Head, through the Church which is his Body. Basing itself on Scripture and Tradition, the Council teaches that the Church, now a pilgrim on earth, is necessary for salvation; he is present to us in his body which is the Church. He himself explicitly asserted the necessity of faith and Baptism, and thereby affirmed at the same time the necessity of the Church which men enter through a door. Hence they could not be saved who knowing the Catholic Church was founded as necessary by God through Christ, would refuse either to enter it or to remain in it.

847 This affirmation is not aimed at those who, through no fault of their own, did know the Gospel of Christ or his Church, but who nevertheless seek God with a sincere heart, and, moved by grace, try in their actions to do his will as they know it through the dictates of their conscience-those too may achieve eternal salvation.

848 Although in ways known to himself God can lead those who, through no fault of their own, are ignorant of the Gospel, to that faith without which it is impossible to please him, the Church still has the obligation and also the sacred right to evangelize all men.

Mission—a requirement of the Church's Catholicity

849 The missionary mandate. "Having been divinely sent to the nations that she might be the universal sacrament of salvation, the Church, in obedience to the command of her founder and because it is demanded by her own essential universality, strives to teach the Gospel to all men.
