Facts of Our Faith

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 3. The Church Is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic
III The Church Is Catholic Mission—a requirement of the
Church's Catholicity

855 The Church's mission stimulates efforts towards Christian
unity. Indeed, "divisions among Christians prevents the Church
from realizing in practice the fullness of Catholicity proper to
her in those of her sons who, though joined to her in Baptism, are
separated from full communion with her. Furthermore, the Church
herself finds it more difficult to express in actual life her full
catholicity in all its aspects.

856 The missionary task implies a respectful dialogue with those
who do not yet accept the Gospel. Believers can profit from this
dialogue by learning to appreciate those elements of truth and
grace that are found among peoples and which are a secret pres-
ence of God. They proclaim the Good News to those who do not
know it in order to consolidate, complete, and raise up the truth
and the goodness that God has distributed among men and nations
and to purify them from error and evil "for the glory of God, the
confusion of the demon, and the happiness of man."

IV The Church is Apostolic

857 The Church is Apostolic because she is founded on the
Apostles in three ways: she was and remains built on "the founda-
tion of the Apostles, the witnesses chosen and sent on mission by
Christ himself: with the help of the Spirit the Church keeps and
passes on the teachings and the words she has heard from the
Apostles; she continues to be taught, sanctified, and guided by the
apostles until Christ's return, through their successors in pastoral
office: the college of bishops, assisted by priests, in union with
the successor of Peter, the Church's supreme pastor.

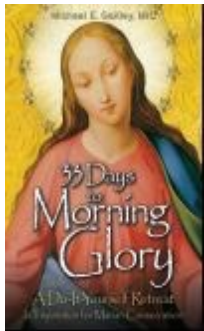
