Facts of Our Faith

Paragraph 3. The Church Is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic

IV The Church is Apostolic
The bishops-----successors of the apostles

861 In order that the mission entrusted to them might be continued after their death, the apostles consigned by will and testament to their immediate collaborators the duty of completing and consolidating the work they had begun, urging them to tend to the whole flock, in which the Holy Spirit had appointed them to shepherd the Church. They accordingly designated such men and then made the ruling that likewise on their death other proven men should take over their ministry.”

862 “ Just as the office which the Lord confided to Peter alone, as first of the apostles, destined to be transmitted to his successors, is a permanent one, so also endures the office which the apostles received of shepherding the Church, a charge destined to be exercised by the sacred order of bishops.” Hence the Church teaches that “the bishops have by divine institution taken the place of the apostles as pastors of the Church, in such ways that whoever listens to them is listening to Christ and whoever despises them despises Christ and him who sent Christ.”

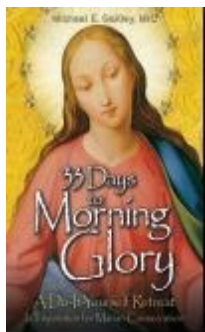
The apostolate

863 The whole Church is apostolic, in that she remains, through the successors of St. Peter and the other apostles, in communion of faith and life with her origin: and in that she is “sent out” into the whole world. All members of the Church share in this mission, though in various ways. “The Christian vocation is a vocation to the apostolate as well.” Indeed, we call an apostolate “every activity of the Mystical Body” that aim to spread the Kingdom of Christ over all the earth.
