Facts of Our Faith

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 3. The Church Is One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic
IV The Church is Apostolic

The apostolate

864 "Christ, sent by the Father, is the source of the Church's whole apostolate"; thus the fruitfulness of apostolate for ordained ministers as well as for lay people clearly depends on their vital union with Christ. In keeping with vocations, the demands of the times and the various gifts of the Holy Spirit, the apostolate assumes the most varied forms. But charity, drawn from the Eucharist above all, is always "as it were, the soul of the whole apostolate."

865 The Church is ultimately one, holy, catholic and apostolic in her deepest identity, because it is in her that "the Kingdom of heaven," the "Reign of God," already exists and will be fulfilled at the end of time. The kingdom has come in the person of Christ and grows mysteriously in the hearts of those incorporated into him, until its full eschatological manifestation. Then all those he has redeemed and made "holy and blameless before him in love, will be gathered together as the one people of God, the "Bride of the Lamb" the "holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God, having the joy of God." For "the wall of the city had twelve foundations and on them the twelve names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb."

866 The Church is one. She acknowledges one Lord, confesses one faith is born of one baptism, forms one body, is given life by one Spirit, for the sake of one hope at whose fulfillment all divisions will be overcome.

867 The Church is holy: the Most Holy God is her author; Christ, her bridegroom, gave himself up to make holy; the Spirit of holiness gives her life.

WEEKLY NEWS

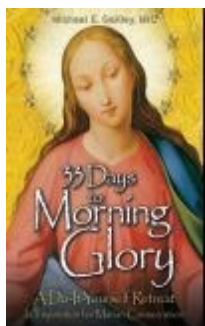
