**Facts of Our Faith**

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----  
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

I. THE HIERARCHICAL CONSTITUTION OF THE CHURCH

The episcopal college and its head, the Pope  
880 When Christ instituted the twelve, "he constituted them in the form of a college or permanent assembly, at the head of which he placed Peter, chosen from among them."

Just as "by the Lord's institution, St. Peter and the rest of the apostles constitute a single apostolic college, so in like fashion the Roman Pontiff, Peter's successor, and the bishops, the successors of the apostles, are related with and united to one another.

881 The Lord made Simon alone, whom he named Peter, the "rock" of his Church. He gave him the keys of his Church and instituted him shepherd of the whole flock. "The office of binding and loosing which was given to Peter was also assigned to the college of apostles united to its head." This pastoral office of Peter and the other apostles belongs to the Church's very foundation and is continued by the bishops under the primacy of the Pope.

882 The Pope, Bishop of Rome and Peter's successor, "is the perpetual and visible source and foundation of the unity both of the bishops and of the whole company of the faithful." "For the Roman Pontiff, by reason of his office as Vicar of Christ, and as Pastor of the entire Church has full, supreme, and universal power over the whole Church, a power which he can always exercise unhindered."

883 "The college or body of bishops has no authority unless united with the Roman Pontiff, Peter's successor, as its head." As such, this college has "supreme and full authority over the universal Church: but this power cannot be exercised without the agreement of the Roman Pontiff."

**THE COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE NEWS:** “As many of you have seen, the columbaria have been “installed” at its place in the meditation garden but the concrete, sprinkler system and garden are still to be started. Concrete work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, August 16th and the sprinkler system and landscaping will follow. This is weather dependent so hopefully the constant raining will end soon. Each columbarium has 32 niches with 8 double-spaced niches on the front and back and 8 single spaced niches on each side for a total of 48 interments. All of the double-spaced niches are licensed on the first columbarium and all but 7 on the second columbarium. Only 3 single-spaced niches are licensed. On Thursday, November 2, All Souls Day 2017 there will be a Mass and ceremony for the installation of those who have been waiting for interment. This will be our opening ceremony for the meditation/prayer garden. Donations will be accepted and appreciated for the St. Ann Columbarium project. Please give us your recommendations so we get approved by Fr. Max (donations other than cash require his review).
