Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful------Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

I. THE HIERARCHICAL CONSTITUTION OF THE CHURCH The episcopal college and its head, the Pope

884 The college of bishops exercises power over the universal Church in an ecumenical council. But there never is an ecumenical council which is not confirmed or at least recognized as such by Peter's successor.

885 This college in so far as it is composed of many members, is the expression and universality of the People of God: and of the unity of the flock of Christ, in so far as it is assembled under one head.

886 "The individual bishops are the visible source and foundation of unity in their own particular Churches." As such they exercise their pastoral offices over the portion of the People of God assigned to them, assisted by priests and deacons. But, as a member of the episcopal college, each bishop shares in the concern for all Churches. The bishops exercise this care first by ruling well their own Churches as portions of the universal Church, and so contributing to the welfare of the whole mystical Body, which is like a corporate body of Churches. They extend it especially to the poor, to those persecuted for their faith, as well as to missionaries working throughout the world.

887 Neighboring Churches who share the same culture, form ecclesiastical provinces or larger grouping called patriarchates or regions. The bishops of these groupings can meet in synods or provincial councils. "In a like fashion, the episcopal conferences at the present time are in a position to contribute in many and fruitful ways to the concrete realization of the collegiate spirit.

THE COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE NEWS: "As many of you have seen, the columbaria have been "installed" at its place in the meditation garden but the concrete, sprinkler system and garden are still to be started. Concrete work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, August 16th and the sprinkler system and landscaping will follow. This is weather dependent so hopefully the constant raining will end soon. Each columbarium has 32 niches with 8 double-spaced niches on the front and back and 8 single spaced niches on each side for a total of 48 interments. All of the double-spaced niches are licensed on the first columbarium and all but 7 on the second columbarium. Only 3 single-spaced niches are licensed. On Thursday, November 2, All Souls Day 2017 there will be a Mass and ceremony for the installation of those who have been waiting for interment. This will be our opening ceremony for the meditation/prayer garden. Donations will be accepted and appreciated for the St. Ann Columbarium project.
