Facts of Our Faith

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

I. THE HIERARCHICAL CONSTITUTION OF THE CHURCH

The teaching office

888 Bishops, with priests as co-workers, have as their first task "to preach the Gospel of God to all men," in keeping with the Lord's command. They are heralds of faith, who draw new disciples to Christ; they are authentic teachers of the apostolic faith endowed with the authority of Christ.

889 In order to preserve the Church in the purity of the faith handed on by the apostles. Christ who is the Truth willed to confer on the Church a share in his own infallibility. By a "supernatural sense of faith," the People of God, under the guidance of the Church's living Magisterium, "unfailingly adheres to this faith."

890 The Mission of the Magisterium is linked to the definitive nature of the covenant established by God with his people in Christ. It is this Magisterium's task to preserve God's people from deviations and defections and to guarantee them the objective possibility of professing the true faith without error. Thus, the pastoral duty of the Magisterium is aimed at seeing to it that the People of God abides in the truth that liberates. To fulfill this service, Christ endowed the Church's shepherds with the Charism of infallibility in matters of faith and morals. The exercise of this charism takes several forms.

891 The Roman Pontiff, head of the college of bishops, enjoys this infallibility by virtue of his office, as supreme pastor and teacher of all the faithful, he proclaims by a definitive act a doctrine pertaining to faith or morals. The infallibility promised to the Church is also present in the body of bishops when together with Peter's successor they exercise the supreme Magisterium, especially in an Ecumenical Council.

MISSION ADVANCEMENT PLANNING: MAP provides a strategic way for our parish and the whole diocese to determine priorities, plans and supportive funding for our future. Through the MAP survey (done earlier this year), we have already begun to invite input from our parishioners regarding what they appreciate most about our parish, what concerns them and what they believe is most important regarding our future. We are currently forming a team of parishioners to study the survey results and move on from that to plan for the future. THE COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE NEWS: "As many of you have seen, the columbaria have been "installed" at its place in the meditation garden but the concrete, sprinkler system and garden are still to be started. Each columbarium has 32 niches with 8 double-spaced niches on the front and back and 8 single spaced niches on each side for a total of 48 interments. All of the double-spaced niches are licensed on the first columbarium and all but 7 on the second columbarium. Only 3 single-spaced niches are licensed. On Thursday, **November 2, All Souls Day 2017** there will be a Mass and ceremony for the installation of those who have been waiting for interment. This will be our opening ceremony for the meditation/prayer garden. Donations will be accepted and appreciated for the St. Ann Columbarium project. Please give us your recommendations so we get approved by Fr. Max (donations other than cash require his review).
