Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----  
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

I. THE HIERARCHICAL CONSTITUTION OF THE CHURCH

The teaching office

**892** Divine assistance is also given to the successors of the apostles, teaching in communion with the successors of Peter, and in a particular way, to the bishop of Rome, pastor of the whole Church, when without arriving at an infallible definition and without pronouncing in a "definitive manner" they propose a teaching that leads to a better understand of Revelation in matters of faith and morals. To this ordinary teaching the faithful are to adhere to it with religious assent which though distinct from the assent of faith, is nonetheless an extension of it.

The sanctifying office

**893** The bishop is "the steward of the grace of the supreme priesthood," especially in the Eucharist which he offers personally or whose offering he assures through the priests, his co-workers. The Eucharist is the center of the life of the Church. The bishop and priests sanctify the Church by their prayer and work, by their ministry of the word and of the sacraments. They sanctify her by their example, "not as domineering over those in their charge but being examples to their flock. Thus, together with the flock entrusted to them, they may attain eternal life.

The governing office

**894** The bishops, as vicars and legates of Christ, govern the particular Churches assigned to them by their counsels, exhortations, and example, but over and above that also by the authority and sacred power which indeed they ought to exercise so as to edify, in the spirit of service which is that of their master

**THE COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE NEWS:** Construction of the columbaria/meditation garden is complete with the exception of the sprinkler system (scheduled to be completed this week – w/o 8/27). The information below has been included in earlier bulletin inserts. Each columbarium has 32 niches with 8 double-spaced niches on the front and back and 8 single spaced niches on each side for a total of 48 interments. All of the double-spaced niches are licensed on the first columbarium and all but 7 on the second columbarium. Only 3 single-spaced niches are licensed. On Thursday, **November 2, All Souls Day 2017** there will be a **9 AM Mass** and ceremony for the installation of those who have been waiting for interment. This will be our opening ceremony for the meditation/prayer garden. Donations will be accepted and appreciated for the St. Ann Columbarium project.
