Facts of Our Faith

I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

I. THE HIERARCHICAL CONSTITUTION OF THE CHURCH

The governing office

894 The bishops, as vicars and legates of Christ, govern the particular Churches assigned to them by their counsels, exhortations, and example, but over and above that also by the authority and sacred power which indeed they ought to exercise so as to edify, in the spirit of service which is that of their Master.

895 "The power which they exercise personally in the name of Christ, is proper ordinary, and immediate, although its exercise is ultimately controlled by the supreme authority of the Church." But the bishops should not be thought of as vicars of the Pope. His ordinary and immediate authority over the whole Church does not annul, but on the contrary confirms and defends that of the bishops. Their authority must be exercised in communion with the whole Church under the guidance of the Pope.

896 The Good Shepherd ought to be the model and form of the bishop's pastoral office.

Conscious of his own weaknesses, "the bishop can have compassion for those who are ignorant and erring. He should not refuse to listen to his subjects whose welfare he promotes as if they were his very own children. The faithful should be very attached to their bishop as the Church is to Jesus Christ, and as Jesus Christ is to the Father.

II THE LAY FAITHFUL

897 The term "laity" is here understood to mean all the faithful except those in Holy Orders and those who belong to a religious state approved by the Church. That is, the faithful, who by Baptism are incorporated into Christ and integrated into the People of God, are made sharers in their particular way in the priestly, prophetic and kingly office of Christ, and have their own part to play in the mission of the whole Christian people in the Church and in the world.

THE COLUMBARIUM COMMITTEE NEWS: Construction of the columbaria/meditation garden is complete with the exception of the sprinkler system (scheduled to be completed this week – w/o 8/27). The information below has been included in earlier bulletin inserts. Each columbarium has 32 niches with 8 double-spaced niches on the front and back and 8 single spaced niches on each side for a total of 48 interments. All of the double-spaced niches are licensed on the first columbarium and all but 7 on the second columbarium. Only 3 single-spaced niches are licensed. On Thursday, **November 2, All Souls Day 2017** there will be a **9 AM Mass** and ceremony for the installation of those who have been waiting for interment. This will be our opening ceremony for the meditation/prayer garden. Donations will be accepted and appreciated for the St. Ann Columbarium project.
