I BELIEVE IN THE HOLY CATHOLIC CHURCH

Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

II THE LAY FAITHFUL

Participation in Christ's prophetic office

904 "Christ fulfills this prophetic office, not only by the hierarchy, but also by the laity. He accordingly both establishes them as witnesses and provides them with the sense of the faith and the grace of the word. To teach and to lead others to faith is the task of every believer.

905 Lay people also fulfill their prophetic mission by evangelization, that is, the proclamation of Christ by word and the testimony of their life. For lay people, this evangelization acquires a specific property because it is accomplished in the ordinary circumstances of the world. The witness of life is not the sole element in the apostolate; the true apostle is on the lookout for occasions of announcing Christ by word, either to unbelievers or to the faithful.

906 Lay people who are capable and trained may also collaborate in catechetical formation, in teaching the sacred sciences, and in use of the communication media.

907 In accord with the knowledge, competence and preeminence which they possess, lay people have the right and even the duty to manifest to the sacred pastors their opinion on matters which pertain to the good of the Church, and they have a right to make their opinion known to other Christian faithful, with due regard to the integrity of faith and morals and reverence toward their pastors, and with consideration for the common good and the dignity of persons.
