Paragraph 4. Christ's Faithful-----  
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

III. The Consecrated Life

The eremitic life

**920** Without always professing the three evangelical counsels publicly, hermits "devote their life to the praise of God and salvation of the world through a stricter separation from the world, the silence of solitude and assiduous prayer and penance."

**921** They manifest to everyone the interior aspect of the mystery of the Church, that is, personal intimacy with Christ. Hidden from the eyes of men, the life of the hermit is a silent preaching of the Lord, to whom he has surrendered his life simply because he is everything to him. Here is a particular call to find in the desert, in the thick of spiritual battle, the glory of the crucified one.

Consecrated virgins and widows

**922** From apostolic times Christian virgins and widows, called by the Lord to cling only to him with greater freedom of heart, body, mind, and spirit have decided, with the Church's approval to live in the respective states of virginity or perpetual chastity," for the sake of the kingdom of heaven."

**923** "Virgins who, committed to the holy plan of following Christ more closely, are consecrated to God by the Diocesan Bishop according to the approved liturgical rite, are betrothed mystically to Christ, the Son of God, and are dedicated to the service of the Church. By this solemn rite the virgin is constituted a sacred person, a transcendent sign of the Church's love for Christ, and an image of this heavenly Bride of Christ and of the life to come.

**924** As with other forms of consecrated life, the order of virgins establishes the woman living in the world (or the nun) in prayer, penance, service of her brethren, and apostolic activity, according to the state of life and spiritual gifts given to her.

**FINANCIAL** - Columbarium Regarding the 6/30/17 parish financial report, the Columbarium collections (\$62, 000) were from license fees paid for niches and a donation identified for this program. All monies associated with the Columbarium are segregated from regular parish funds. At 6/30/17 there was Columbarium cash (\$27,562.80) and savings (\$20,002.47) and a payable of \$11,937.20 leaving \$35,628.07 for Columbarium expenditures after 6/30/17.
