Paragraph 4. Christ’s Faithful-----
Hierarchy, Laity, Consecrated Life

III. The Consecrated Life

Secular institutes

928 A secular institute is an institute of consecrated life in which the Christian faithful living in the world strive for the perfection of charity and work for the sanctification of the world especially from within.

929 By a life perfectly and entirely consecrated to sanctification, the members of these institutes share in the Church’s task of evangelization in the world where their presence acts as leaven in the world. Their witness of a Christian life aims to order temporal things according to God and inform the world with the power of the gospel. They commit themselves to the evangelical counsels by sacred bonds and observe among themselves the communion and fellowship appropriate to their particular secular way of life.

Societies of apostolic life

930 Alongside the different forms of consecrated life are societies of apostolic life whose members, without religious vows, pursue the particular apostolic purpose of their societies and lead a life as brothers or sisters in common according to a particular manner of life, strive for the perfection of charity through the observance of their constitutions. Among these there are societies in which the members embrace the evangelical counsels of poverty chastity and obedience, according to their constitutions.

Already destined for him through Baptism, the person who surrenders himself to the God he loves above all else thereby consecrates himself more intimately to God’s service and to the good of the whole church.
