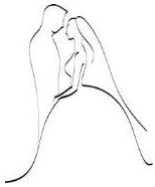

COVID 19 REMINDER: Over the past 11 months we have had to deal with mandatory shutdowns, not traveling, not seeing family and friends like we used to, wearing masks, shortages and washing our hands every 10 minutes or so and through it all our little parish has stayed relatively safe. Maybe because of that, we had become a little lax in our gathering and social distancing. Right before Christmas a small number of cases were confirmed among parishioners and Masses were cancelled over the Christmas Holidays. As Masses resume, **we are reminding people that masks are mandatory in the church. Maintain a safe distance inside and outside. Don't gather inside the church or in the parking lot. If you are not feeling well or have been around someone who is sick please stay home. If you think you have been exposed, get tested.** This is hard for all of us because this is one of the only places we get to see our friends. But in order to keep the church open we have to follow these guidelines.
