THE SANCTUARY LAMP signals the Eucharistic presence of the Lord Jesus in the tabernacle and burns continuously for 7 days. You may have the sanctuary lamp memorialized for either a sick person, a deceased loved one, or a special intention, for a weekly donation of \$25.00. To schedule a date, check the sheet on the bulletin board in the hall and then fill out an envelope found on the credenza for this purpose.

<u>ALTAR FLOWERS:</u> Parishioners who would like to place flowers on the altar for a special request on any weekend, please sign up on the sheet on the bulletin board. Flowers are for altar (in front) and/or for the flower stands. Real flowers are preferred. You may order the flowers yourself, use flowers from your garden, or use potted plants which can be taken home afterwards.
