SR. THEA BOWMAN, SERVANT OF GOD  
1937-1990

Servant of God Thea Bowman was a Franciscan Sister of Perpetual Adoration and the first African-American woman to address the U.S. Bishop's Conference.

In her role as Consultant, Sister Thea gave presentations across the country, lively gatherings that combined singing, gospel preaching, prayer and storytelling. Her programs were directed to breakdown racial and culture barriers, her religious order reports. She encouraged people to communicate with one another so they could understand other cultures and races.

"I think the difference between me and some people is that I am content to do my little bit. Sometimes people think they have to do big things in order to make change .But if each one would light one candle, we'd have a tremendous light."

She called on Catholics to celebrate their differences and to retain their cultures, but to reflect their joy at being reflect their joy at being one in Christ.

She was declared a Servant of God  
(2nd step to sainthood) 5/2018.
