**WHAT ARE THE EFFECTS OF BAPTISM?**

- Baptism forgives both Original Sin and personal sins and remits
- all punishment due to sin. However, some consequences of sin remain, for example, suffering, weakness of character, inclination to sin (traditionally called concupiscence) and death.
- Baptism makes us into a new creation, imparting in us life in
- Christ. It makes us children of God and temples of the Holy Spirit. Baptism confers sanctifying grace, the grace of justification,
- enabling us to believe, to hope, and to love. It also gives us the Holy Spirit and the Spirit's gifts, which enable us to grow in holiness and goodness.
- Baptism initiates and incorporates us into Christ's Body, the
- Church. It empowers us to share in Christ's priestly ministry of worship and service. Baptism joins us to all Christians, even to those who are not yet fully united to the Catholic Church.
