Mary, you are the mother of the Word Incarnate: the happiest of all human beings, because you spoke to the Word of God. You are the Queen of the Apostles, and you spoke, reminding the apostles of Jesus' words and commenting on them.

But you are also the Mother of interior silence, because you listened to what the Word told you. You allowed the Holy Spirit to address you, and you were attentive to the teaching that your Son, the Word, gave to his apostles. What you do, you do for the Church.
