A CALL TO ALL SOUTH CAROLINA CATHOLICS to Pray the Rosary on **October 17 at 7pm**. We have a chance to make South Carolina a safe harbor for unborn children, but we need everyone praying the rosary! **October 17 at 7p.m.** has been designated in our state as a special hour to pray the Rosary, for the intention of passing a strong pro-life version of H. 5399, to be considered October 18 by the S.C. Senate. Please pray—in church, at an abortion facility, or at home—at that hour! It is also vital that everyone call their state Senator and urge him or her to go to Columbia on October 18 and vote to recede and thereby send H. 5399 to the Governor's desk for his signature.
