

**BAPTISM**: Call the Rectory at least one month before the proposed date to arrange for preparation and date for Baptism. Parents must be registered and active parishioners for at least 3 months prior to the Baptism. **MATRIMONY**: If you are a Catholic and want to be married (even if at another church) you must call the Rectory at least six months prior to the proposed date to arrange for marriage.
