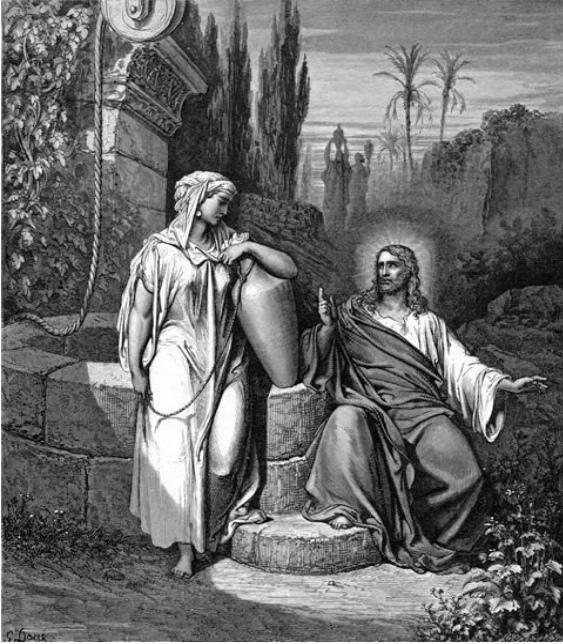

**MATRIMONY:** If you are a Catholic and want to be married (even if at another church) you must call the Rectory at least six months prior to the proposed date to arrange for marriage.
