**Luke 24: 30-32** “While he was with them at table, he took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him, but he vanished from their sight. Then they said to each other, “Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to Us?”

“See here the power and effect of the Eucharist,” wrote Cornelius a Lapide. “It opens and illuminates the eyes of the mind to know Jesus.” This Emmaus encounter is an image of what happens for us at every Mass: the Scriptures are opened for us and the Lord, through his priests, gives us the Bread of Life.
