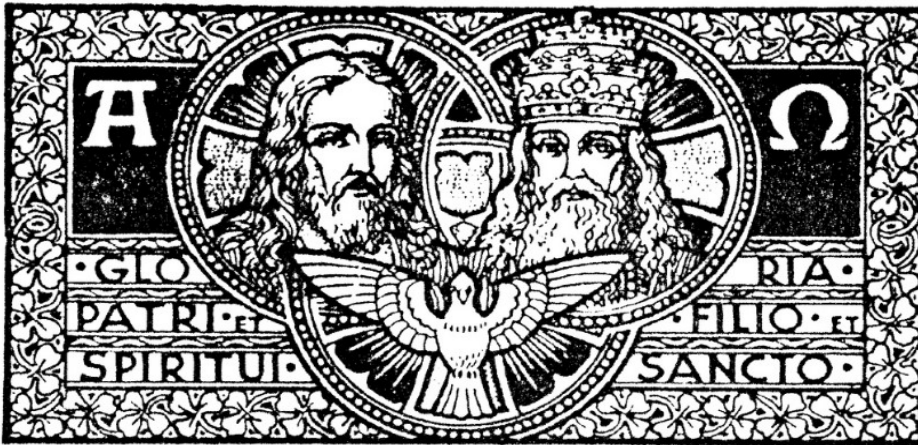

**BAPTISM:** Call the Rectory at least one month before the proposed date to arrange for preparation and date for Baptism. Parents must be registered and active parishioners for at least 3 months prior to the Baptism.

**MATRIMONY:** If you are a Catholic and want to be married (even if at another church) you must call the Rectory at least six months prior to the proposed date to arrange for marriage.

### **The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity**

The Catechism teaches that “by sending his only Son and the Spirit of Love in the fullness of time, God has revealed his innermost secret: God himself is an eternal exchange of love, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and he has destined us to share in that exchange” By worshiping the Trinity we realize the full truth of ourselves. “The three persons are one truth” (St Augustine). This truth is the saving truth of God’s own life, which we begin to live on earth by the gift of faith. “The complete Trinity dwells in us” God reveals the fullness of his very self to us that we “might not perish but might have eternal life,” and that we might be received as his own.
